1. Who killed Harold Green?
2. Who stole his watch?
3. Who stole the church donation box?

If you believe you can answer these questions, we may have reason to re-open the case and begin investigating again, despite the time elapsed. If you have a sufficient lead, please pass the details over to the Royal Prosecution Service at ThinkFun.com/ColdCase. From there, we will review if the evidence is sufficient for re-examination.

Melbury has never forgotten Harold Green. Please help us find cause to re-open the case.
